### **Honorary Doctor of Laws**

Sandra DeLaronde is a champion of social change who works tirelessly to amplify the voices of Indigenous people in Manitoba. Raised in a strong and vibrant Métis family, she is a member of Cross Lake First Nation with roots at the Métis settlement of Duck Bay.

A passionate community builder. Del aronde has made it her life's work to end violence and support the families of Missing and Murdered Women, Girls, and 2-Spirited persons (MMIWG2S). As co-chair of Manitoba's MMIWG2S Coalition, she is a powerful voice for Manitoba families in the Commission of a National Inquiry into Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women, Girls and 2-Spirited Persons, ensuring the hearts of families and survivors are honoured and protected.

She played an instrumental role in developing and managing the Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Scholarship, which was established in 2000 to honour the life and legacy of its namesake, who was murdered in The Pas in 1976. This scholarship has delivered over \$1 million in direct bursary support to hundreds of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students pursuing post-secondary education in Manitoba.

DeLaronde worked closely with The University of Winnipeg's Office of Indigenous Affairs to incorporate Star Blanket teachings into the campus - integrating a Star Blanket mural on the Helen Betty Osborne building and as a theme throughout convocations and the Spring Feast.

DeLaronde is generous in sharing her knowledge and culture with others. As head woman for the Ovate Wiwanyang Wacipi (Sundance) and the Heart of the White Buffalo Moondance, she plays a vital role in strengthening Indigenous ceremony, practice, and tradition.

Whether heading a project or chairing a heated meeting of diverse perspectives. DeLaronde leads with a combination of authority, generosity, and empathy that bridges difficult conversations and influences change. This is evident in her work with national, provincial, and local women's and Aboriginal women's organizations in support of community development, cultural reclamation, and reconciliation.

### **Honorary Doctor of Laws**

Throughout a remarkable, varied, and decorated career, Thomas Denton has left an indelible mark on the city, province, and country in myriad ways, none greater than his ceaseless efforts to improve the lives of the oppressed and marginalized who have sought a higher station of life in Canada.

A graduate of Acadia University and Dalhousie University's School of Law, Denton found his calling in 1984 when the International Centre of Winnipeg sought to replace its executive director. Denton – who served 14 years in the Royal Canadian Naval Reserves, from which he retired as Lieutenant-Commander and for which he received the Canadian Forces Decoration – assumed the role and became the face of refugee sponsorship in Manitoba.

Through his work, he helped reshape Winnipeg's downtown core into one of the most welcoming and culturally diverse in Canada, created transitional housing for those arriving in the city, and doggedly fought for government support of subsidized housing. But Denton was more than a behind-the-scenes figure to those he helped. He has been personally involved in the settling of more than 40,000 individuals in Canada and has at times been a one-man welcoming committee —

on hand to greet many of those whose first destination was Winnipeg. After departing International Centre of Winnipeg at the turn of the millennium, Denton continued his work as a policy consultant and as executive director of the non-government organization Hospitality House Refugee Ministry.

Denton has been an integral contributor to the arts community in Winnipeg. In 1980, following the closure of the Winnipeg *Tribune*, he became the founding publisher of the Winnipeg Sun, a post he retained until its sale in 1983. Additionally, he was among the trustees who successfully endeavoured to save the Winnipeg Symphony. A generous volunteer who served on numerous committees, commissions, and boards - including those of the Prairie Theatre Exchange, Stage West, Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre, Walker Theatre, and Manitoba Museum -Denton was also the first chairperson of the City of Winnipeg Arts Council.

For his tireless commitment to humanitarian efforts and advocacy for human rights, in addition to his services to Winnipeg's arts community, The University of Winnipeg proudly bestows an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Thomas Denton.



Patricia Parker BA, MA, PhD

#### **Honorary Doctor of Laws**

For more than 40 years, Dr. Patricia Parker has been a dedicated and innovative educator, academic, scholar, and author. Her ties to The University of Winnipeg date back to 1967, when she graduated from United College. After receiving her MA in English at the University of Toronto, Parker taught for three years in Tanzania as a CUSO volunteer, first for the Ministry of Education and then as a lecturer at the University of East Africa. After completing her PhD in Comparative Literature at Yale, she returned to the University of Toronto where she taught for 11 years.

In 1986, she was invited to Stanford as Visiting Professor and has been a permanent professor at the institution in English and Comparative Literature since 1988.

Parker is the author of four books:
Inescapable Romance: Studies in the Poetics
of a Mode; Literary Fat Ladies: Rhetoric,
Gender, Property; Shakespeare from the
Margins: Language, Culture, Context; and
Shakespearean Intersections: Language,
Contexts, Critical Keywords. She's also the
co-editor of five collections of essays covering
criticism, theory, race, and cultural studies.

Known as one of the most original interpreters of Shakespeare, Parker's Shakespeare from the Margins placed her at the centre of Shakespearean studies after insisting his language must be interpreted from diverse perspectives, including race, religion, sexuality, and gender. UWinnipeg English Chair Brandon Christopher said

that Parker's third book "cemented her reputation as one of the most important and insightful scholars in Shakespeare studies," while her fourth book "is dazzling in its clarity and its ambition, taking the reader on a seamless exploration of both the specificity of language as it was used in Shakespeare's plays and the complex web of culture out of which that language emerged."

Parker has made it her mission to bring literature to those outside the university by organizing public festivals and working with students to create performance-based programs within the community. Most notably, she's the editor of the nearly two-million-word *Stanford Global Shakespeare Encyclopedia*, which will be launched in 2021-22 as an open-access online resource for students, scholars, and the public.

A sought-after speaker, Parker has lectured all over the world, from France, Germany, and Spain, to Australia, New Zealand, and the Czech Republic. She has also been a Gauss Seminar lecturer at Princeton, was a Shakespeare's Birthday lecturer at Folger Shakespeare Library, and was named a Northrop Frye Professor in Literary Theory at the University of Toronto.

For her contribution to a generation of students, her masterful scholarship, and for championing the place of literature inside and outside post-secondary institutions, The University of Winnipeg is proud to bestow an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Patricia Parker.

# **Erica and Arnold Rogers Award** for Excellence in Research and Scholarship

Dr. Christopher Bidinosti and Dr. Christopher Henry are visionary researchers whose combined expertise and commitment to interdisciplinary collaboration is advancing digital agriculture and driving innovation.

Both as individual researchers and as a team, they have forged successful industry-academia partnerships that have opened doors to the development of new technologies that wouldn't be possible without their combined talents in physics and applied computer science.

Dr. Bidinosti's research centres around novel methods of nuclear magnetic resonance and its application in diverse fields such as medical imaging and fundamental physics.

Dr. Henry's expertise is in the development of theoretical frameworks that model human perception for machine learning applications.

It has been close to a decade since the pair began working together, united by a mutual interest in GPU-based computing and their shared understanding of its capacity to solve problems that impact

every domain of research and industry. A hallway conversation led to an ongoing research partnership and the development of a state-of-the-art computing laboratory that is home to a large and successful research program with 20 researchers across five disciplines, collaborations with approximately 12 industry partners, and more than \$3 million in funding.

Their shared vision of creating a highquality, labelled image database that is accessible to industry and academy and can be used to train computers and robots to recognize prairie crops will have a profound impact on local and global food production for generations to come.

For their unique and innovative multi-disciplinary collaboration, The University of Winnipeg is proud to present Dr. Christopher Bidinosti and Dr. Christopher Henry with the Erica and Arnold Rogers Award for Excellence in Research and Scholarship.

Eliakim M. Sibanda is a globally acclaimed advocate for human rights, peace, and justice. His knowledge and community engagement have enriched the university community, our neighbourhoods, and beyond.

An eminently qualified intellectual. Sibanda has been pivotal in developing several notable Masters programs at UWinnipeg. He helped create The University of Winnipeg's Global College, helped establish the BA in Human Rights and Global Studies - the first in Western Canada – and was instrumental to the establishment of the Oral History Centre at UWinnipeg. He also played a pivotal role in establishing the joint UWinnipeg/ Winnipeg Art Gallery Chair in History of Indigenous Arts in North America, the first of its kind in Canada.

Known for his humour and supportive, friendly manner, Sibanda has maintained an impressive track record at UWinnipeg as a leader. He has served on several important campus committees and possesses an ability to negotiate different perspectives that result in consensus. In addition to hosting Black History Month, Sibanda has brought many gifted scholars to campus, enriching the UWinnipeg community and promoting cross-cultural understanding.

Sibanda has been a visiting professor at institutions around the world and an external examiner in both local and international universities. He has been an invited speaker to three continents, including Africa, on a range of issues that focus on peace, justice, and human rights advocacy - helping to raise UWinnipeg's profile abroad.

Locally, Sibanda generously volunteers his time to foster community awareness among different groups in Manitoba, including several refugee and new immigrant organizations. He has served as an academic advisor to African communities across the province and helped establish the African Communities of Manitoba Scholarship. He also mentors many students and is involved with youth development programs that deal with a range of topics, including gang violence.

Dr. Anna Stokke is an ambassador for math education whose high standard of teaching and research inspires student success.

Her commitment to teaching excellence has been recognized with a series of awards, including most recently a 2021 3M National Teaching Fellowship -Canada's most prestigious recognition of excellence in post-secondary teaching and educational leadership. She balances innovative classroom teaching with community service, a high level of administrative leadership, NSERC-funded research, and media availability for interviews on math education.

Stokke is a gifted educator who goes out of her way to create an engaging atmosphere in which students excel. Whether mentoring advanced math majors undertaking complicated research projects or teaching first-year students, she incorporates techniques like scaffolding to introduce new concepts in incremental steps that allow students to experience success faster. On her public YouTube channel, she posts videos of herself working through math problems for viewing by her own students as well as those in other classes.

Stokke's passion for the material inspires students to become extremely engaged and work hard to succeed in her classes. "I lose track of time during her lectures," said one of her students. "She makes extremely complicated material simple. She makes learning math fun."

UWinnipeg student Gabriella Borelli said that Stokke's first-year calculus course changed her life. "If it was not for Dr. Stokke's excellent teaching and inspiration, I do not believe I would have pursued a career in math. She truly is my role model. I strongly believe that if every student had the opportunity to learn through Dr. Stokke's teaching, there would not only be far more students pursuing a career in mathematics, but there would also be a significant increase in students confident in their mathematical ability."

Stokke's passion extends beyond her classroom. Former students who have become teachers often look to her for advice when teaching their own students. When Max Bennett became a math teacher, she reached out to him, not only to say congratulations, but also to make sure he had the resources he needed to ensure his students' success.

Dr. Anna Stokke is a gifted educator whose passion for her subject and belief that mathematics can and should be accessible to everyone inspires students to engage, excel, and succeed. # **Andrea McCluskey**

### Stars of Spence Street Prize

For more than two decades, Andrea McCluskey dedicated her career to advocating for students who are overcoming cultural, social, and academic barriers.

Often the first point of contact for Indigenous and international students beginning their studies at The University of Winnipeg, she is known for creating a warm, welcoming environment for students navigating a brand-new world.

With both the Aboriginal Student Services Centre (ASSC) and International, Immigrant, and Refugee Student Services (IIRSS), McCluskey's focus has always been to ensure every student that walks through her office door achieves their full potential.

When asked to describe McCluskey, her ASSC colleagues said: "She leads by example - always with unconditional positive regard for students, faculty, and staff."

Throughout her leadership with the ASSC, McCluskey worked countless hours developing a seamless student service model, incorporating academic supports as well as holistic, cultural, and spiritual accommodations all geared towards student success.

McCluskey was instrumental in developing the centre, which opened in 2004 and is a place many Indigenous students call

their "home away from home." Under her direction, Indigenous student retention and recruitment rates have steadily increased, reaching 11 per cent of the overall student population.

She was also integral in the development of the Transition Year Program, which helps new Indigenous students build the academic and personal coping skills to foster their post-secondary success.

A talented quilter, McCluskey volunteers her time teaching students the craft while building community, talking about education, and imparting knowledge. Upon the arrival of COVID-19, she began hosting a weekly virtual quilting workshop for Indigenous and international students as a way of welcoming and connecting them.

Over the years, McCluskey's presence has positively affected so many lives at UWinnipeg. Everything she does is because she truly cares about the wellbeing of the students and her colleagues.

For always leading by example with kindness, compassion, and humanity, The University of Winnipeg is proud to award Andrea McCluskey the Stars of Spence Street Prize.

### **Professor Emeritus**

Throughout his 36-year career at The University of Winnipeg, which lasted until his retirement in 2012, John Lehr exemplified creativity, curiosity, and dedication to his work. He was a beloved, enthusiastic, and incredibly well-respected professor in the Department of Geography.

A prolific publisher with more than 100 publications to his name, Lehr was among UWinnipeg's top researchers. He provided works to regional journals and national publications, and presented throughout Canada and abroad. Lehr published six books, including *Inside the Ark*: The Hutterites in Canada and the United States, with Dr. Yossi Katz, and Community and Frontier: A Ukrainian Settlement in the Canadian Parkland, both of which received the Margaret McWilliams Award for Scholarly History from the Manitoba Historical Society.

Lehr's interest in and research of the settlement of the Canadian prairies is world renowned, and he is an authority on the ways in which ethnic and religious groups such as Hutterites, Ukrainians, Jews, Mennonites, and Mormons shaped the cultural landscape.

Affectionately known as 'Jock', Lehr was always eager to mentor and was a regular thesis supervisor for UWinnipeg's honours students. He encouraged them to refine and deepen their work and to present it both regionally and nationally. Lehr has been praised for his teaching style, affability, willingness to provide guidance, and interest in the careers of students. His influence was recognized in 2005 when he was awarded the Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award For Excellence in Teaching, as chosen by a committee of faculty, staff, and students.

Beyond UWinnipeg, Lehr has served at the national, provincial, and municipal level, including leadership positions with the Canadian Ethnic Studies Association, Social Science and Humanities Research Council Evaluation Committee, Manitoba Museum Board of Governors, Manitoba Historical Society, and Heritage Winnipeg.

For his outstanding scholarship, exceptional research, and commitment to students, The University of Winnipeg is proud to honour John Lehr as Professor Emeritus.



**Royden Loewen**

#### **Professor Emeritus**

Royden Loewen is a prolific scholar in the area of Mennonite history. His distinguished work in teaching, mentorship, and research, while serving as Chair in Mennonite Studies for over two decades, reflects his commitment to and extraordinary influence in his field of study.

Loewen's vast range of scholarship delves into economics, gender, and religious life of the everyday, set within migration and environmental history, all with the aim of explaining the survival and transformation of a major cultural group that retains high visibility in Manitoba, across the Americas, and indeed around the world. His enormous body of interdisciplinary study, devoted to the history of Mennonite communities, transcends continents and has illuminated many facets of ethno-cultural and social history. He has continued to receive Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC) funding for his work.

As founding director of the Centre for Transnational Mennonite Studies, Loewen has built on a program established by his predecessor, Dr. Harry Loewen, and looked for opportunities of giving Mennonite Studies a global standing and communicating scholarship to a broad

audience that extends beyond academia. He has served as a visiting scholar nationally and internationally, including at Cambridge University.

As Chair in Mennonite Studies, Loewen convened or co-convened 25 conferences and his impressive list of publications include 10 books (that is, 7 monographs, 2 co-authored monographs and 1 edited volume), 25 scholarly articles, 13 book chapters, and 75 book reviews. He has adjudicated 12 book manuscripts. He was editor of the Journal of Mennonite Studies for 24 years and is series editor of the Ethnicity and Culture History Series at University of Manitoba Press.

Loewen's personable nature, sharp intellect, and engaged teaching style enhanced the student experience, undergraduate and graduate alike, and helped advance the students' own career and publication possibilities. cementing his leading role as a scholar in Mennonite historical studies.

For his prodigious scholarship, teaching, and significant contributions to the field of Mennonite history, The University of Winnipeg is proud to honour Royden Loewen as Professor Emeritus.

# Fellowship in United College

Throughout her remarkable 45-year career, Judith Huebner made important, lasting contributions in teaching, research, and service.

Arriving at The University of Winnipeg in 1975, Huebner joined the Department of Biology as an instructor during a period of rapid curricular expansion. Over the decades, she took on many teaching roles across the curriculum, as well as coordination of the department's large first-year courses and four-year honours students' theses.

Former department Chair Ed Byard described Huebner as a "clear and committed voice in departmental matters." She was also deeply committed to selfgovernance and had a sterling record in administrative service: she held the role of Associate Dean of Arts and Science for six years starting in 1992, was Acting Dean in 1997, and served as special assistant to UWinnipeg President Constance Rooke from 1999 - 2002

In 2002. Huebner returned to the Department of Biology as a professor before becoming Acting Chair of the Departments of Political Science and Women's and Gender Studies, Huebner once again returned to the Department of Biology in 2014, where she served as Chair until her retirement in June 2020.

Whether supporting students, faculty members, or staff, Huebner was committed to the advancement of women in academics. While attentiveness to women's issues may seem an inevitable part of our scholarly and social landscape now, that was far from the case in the early years of her feminist activism.

This integration of real-life activism and academic expertise is evidenced by Huebner's significant role in establishing the Prairie Regional Centre of Excellence for Women's Health, her long-standing service to the Women's Health Clinic, and her work on the advisory panels for the Institute of Women's and Gender Studies and the Margaret Lawrence Endowment for Women's Studies. She has also been a member of the NSERC selection review panel for the Chair in Women in Science and Engineering, and for over a decade was a board member of the Centre of Excellence in Women's Health.

The University of Winnipeg proudly honours Judith Huebner with Fellowship in United College for her distinguished career in academics, self-governance, and activism within the institution.

Anya Ingram is an accomplished student known for her enthusiasm and passion for human geography, city planning, and public space. Her travels helped her see urban planning through a fresh lens, and she plans to use these experiences to contribute to urban environments here in Canada.

This fall, Ingram will continue her work on urban environments: beginning a Master of Arts in Planning at the University of Waterloo. She intends to become a professional urban/city planner with a focus on the intersection of transportation, public participation, and sustainability in urban environments.

One of his most memorable university experiences was in a first-year earth science course with Dr. Ed Cloutis. The lecture began normally enough with Cloutis explaining about sedimentary layers of rocks and their physical and chemical properties.

"Then, mid-sentence, he takes the piece of chalk in his hand and begins to eat it, with no explanation, and carries on with the lesson," said Kiddell.

Kiddell went on to work in Cloutis's C-TAPE laboratory where he excelled as a research assistant. In this role, he engaged in field research locally and internationally and was first author on a research article in The Journal of Geophysical Research, as well as co-author of research articles. in Icarus and The Astronomical Journal

Years after their first meeting, Kiddell asked Cloutis about the chalk. He smiled and replied with a question of his own, "how do you get students to pay attention and remember you?"

As Kiddell gets set to embark on a career at the head of his own classroom. it's a lesson he will never forget.
