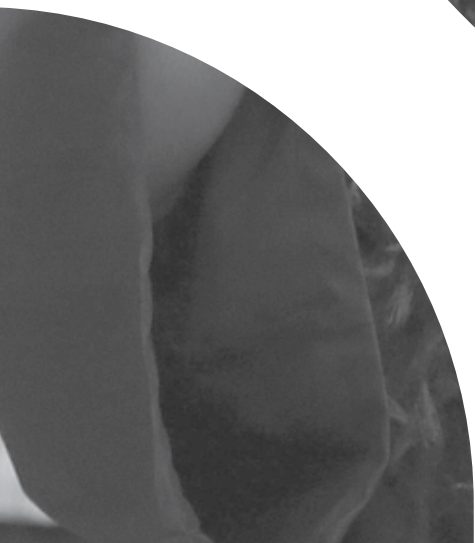

# Convocation Tradition



## Academic Dress

Academic dress originated in medieval times to provide warmth in the damp halls of learning. In its present form, it includes a gown, hood (worn over the shoulders) and, a cap or mortarboard. All universities have distinctive dress for each degree offered, which explains the variety seen in the academic procession.

The University of Winnipeg academic dress conforms to the North American Intercollegiate Code. All graduates wear a black gown, which varies according to the degree conferred. The bachelor's gown is worn closed in front and is distinguished by its pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn either open or closed in front and has closed sleeves with an opening to free the hands. The front portion of the sleeve below the opening has a long semi-circular cut-out. Doctorate gowns also may be worn open or closed. They are faced with velvet.

The edging colour on the hood indicates the faculty in which a degree is conferred: Graduate Studies – red; Science – gold; Education – blue; Arts – white; Business and Economics – brown; Kinesiology and Applied Health – green.

The width of edging is determined by the degree: three inches for doctors; two for masters and bachelors. Hoods are lined in red with a white chevron.

Honorary doctors' gowns are red in colour and are faced with white velvet. They are worn with red Tudor bonnets. The hood colour signifies the honorary degree: white for Laws; golden yellow for Science; admiralty blue for Letters; purple for Divinity. Hoods are lined in red and white – The University of Winnipeg colours. Fellows wear a gown of blue with neither hat nor hood. Members of the University's senior administration wear gowns of varying colours. They do not wear hoods.



## Indigenous Graduation Stoles

Destiny Seymour is an Anishinaabe interior designer who is creating her own textiles that are reviving local Indigenous pottery and bone tool patterns from Manitoba. These ancient patterns have been dated from 400 to over 3,000 years old. Indigo Arrows is a company founded by Destiny that turns these textiles into modern home goods.

Destiny was approached to design custom graduation stoles for the Indigenous graduating students of The University of Winnipeg.

Each linen stole is handmade and block printed in Winnipeg. The pattern design is inspired by the repeated and delicate pattern stamping found on local Indigenous pottery, with colours reflecting The University of Winnipeg.



## The University of Winnipeg Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms of The University of Winnipeg was officially adopted by the governing bodies of The University during the academic session of 1972-73. The elements found within the Coat of Arms have been associated over the years with both Manitoba and Wesley Colleges, the ancestors of United College. The bunch of grapes in the lower portion of the inner shield derives from the Coat of Arms of Manitoba College. The grape symbol has its origin in the College seal adopted in the charter of 1871. The cross, the lamp, and the open book derive from the Coat of Arms of Wesley College, designed in 1897 by Dr. J.H. Riddell. The cross – the symbol of sacrificial service in the interest of humanity – was the basis for his design and upon it he placed a shield – the symbol of protection. The lamp – the symbol of light – also represents learning, to which the Colleges have been devoted for over a century in the Province of Manitoba. The open book – representing instruction in the way of life and the bringing of understanding to the student – symbolizes knowledge in a general sense, although it may carry overtones of the Holy Scriptures in a more limited interpretation.

The motto, placed upon a scroll below, is the United College motto, here retained: *Lux et Veritas Floreant* (Let Light and Truth Flourish). The words catch the central import of the lamp (light) and the open book (truth), and express the hope that both may flourish (as the grape) in our country (the cross).



## Teaching of the Star Blanket

Across many Indigenous Nations, the foundational understanding is that we are all related. This understanding includes our relationship to all beings everywhere – and to all things, from the earth to the sky and beyond. In this understanding, we are beings that come from the stars and our relationship extends to this dimension. The teachings and gifts of the Star Blanket extend from this understanding.

The teaching of the Star Blanket is different across nations. Though the purpose remains the same, it is a healing modality.

From the Ojibwe comes the story of a young baby that had an incurable illness. Her family took her to a medicine woman, who after four days was given the teaching to make a Star Blanket and wrap the little one in it. It was the star people that would do the healing. After four days of ceremony, the little girl was unwrapped.

From the Dakota comes the teaching that the blanket represents the star that we come from, and to be wrapped in the blanket reconnects to our original home and a place of safety.

From the Cree comes a similar teaching, though the points of the star are different.

Today, the Star Blanket is often used as a gift of honour and recognition of relationships. How honourable it is indeed to be given a gift that reconnects the recipient to the spirit of all things.

## Honourees



### Ross Stokke

PhD, MSc, BSc (Hons)

#### **Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award for Teaching Excellence**

Dr. Ross Stokke has taught university mathematics for over 20 years. He teaches some of the most difficult courses and gets glowing student reviews - with nearly one hundred per cent satisfactory ratings on all his student evaluations of teaching.

His expert teaching methods and passion for the subject help make math accessible and enjoyable to all. He dedicates a tremendous amount of time to creating a positive, enriching, and effective learning experience for students. He has supervised many postdocs, graduate students, and undergraduate research assistants, with whom he has published several papers.

Ross's leadership and initiative have improved the student programming in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics.

He played a major role in the creation of an open-access online pre-calculus review workshop for introductory calculus courses.

During his stint as department chair, and as chair of his department's curriculum committee, he helped develop several courses, one of which helps prepare students for challenging upper-level

theoretical math courses.

In the wider community, Ross is vice-president of the non-profit Archimedes Math Schools, which offers low-cost, after-school math lessons for children. He developed many of their math resources, which focus on math skills and enrichment activities. Each year, he delivers math-interest lessons on topics that include the four-colour theorem and the notion of infinity.

He has also participated in other math-related initiatives, such as the Math Readiness Workshops at the Wii Chiiwaakanak Learning Centre, the Kangaroo Math Contest, and the Manitoba Schools Science Symposium.

For his demonstrated excellence in teaching, The University of Winnipeg is proud to honour Dr. Ross Stokke with the Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award for Teaching Excellence.



## Honourees



### **Victor Pruden**

Bachelor of Arts (BA)

#### **Distinguished Alumni Award**

Victor Pruden's illustrious career in basketball spans over 60 years, many of which directly impacted students, players, and coaches in the University of Winnipeg athletic program.

Vic's coaching career began in 1953. He made history in 1966 when he transitioned to university level basketball and started the first intercollegiate men's program at United College; later becoming The University of Winnipeg in 1967.

In 1967, Vic founded the Golden Boy Tournament, a groundbreaking university invitational tournament that would eventually become the Wesmen Classic. To date, the Wesmen Classic is the longest running UWinnipeg sporting tradition. In 1972, Vic started the varsity women's basketball program at the University of Winnipeg.

More than just a basketball coach, Vic was a life coach for the students and athletes. He believed that education should include both academics and athletics, and it was this that guided his career.

Described as an innovator and leader, in 1968, Vic was part of a group of coaches who founded the Manitoba Basketball Coaches Association, which he was named the first president.

He was instrumental in planning and coordinating the Basketball Hall of Fame and Museum, now at the Duckworth Centre at the University of Winnipeg. Vic was inducted into this same Hall of Fame as a Builder in 1994.

For building, growing and solidifying the game of basketball in Manitoba, The University of Winnipeg Alumni Association is proud to honour Victor Pruden with the Distinguished Alumni Award.

## Honourees



### Christopher Wiebe

PhD, MSc, BSc

#### **The Erica and Arnold Rogers Award for Excellence in Research and Scholarship**

Dr. Christopher Wiebe is a quantum material scientist who began his university career at The University of Winnipeg with a BSc in Physics and Chemistry. He returned to UWinnipeg in 2009 as a Professor of Chemistry, and has since become one of the most accomplished members of the Chemistry department.

Chris has an impressive research and teaching career and an international reputation in physical chemistry, neutron scattering, and complex magnetism. He is recognized globally for his leadership in crystal growth, crystallography, and bulk property measurements.

He has over sixty million dollars in research funding to date, including an NSERC Discovery Grant and a one million-dollar CFI grant. He also became a Tier II Canada Research Chair in Quantum Materials Discovery.

Many of the materials that Dr. Wiebe designs in his laboratory have profound technological applications. One of his research specialties - high temperature superconductivity - has the potential to change the world, much like the silicon revolution did.

Chris has produced over 130 publications in top-quality journals. He was a Leverhulme Visiting Professor at the University of Edinburgh, a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry, and a Fellow of the Quantum Materials division of the Canadian Institute for Advanced Research.

Chris built a research program at UWinnipeg with a number of exceptional students. His mentorship is commendable and has led to many successful research careers.

For demonstrated excellence in research and scholarship, The University of Winnipeg is proud to honour Dr. Christopher Wiebe with The Erica and Arnold Rogers Award for Excellence in Research and Scholarship.

## Honourees



### John Smyth

BA, BSW, MSW

#### Honorary Doctor of Laws

John Smyth helped advance mental health services to the immigrant and refugee communities in Canada.

He was a social worker, family therapist, and mental health clinician for 26 years before becoming Executive Director of Aurora Family Therapy Centre at the University in 2011.

Over the following decade, under John's leadership, the centre quadrupled its staff and grew its operating budget sixfold.

John recognized Aurora needed to serve the mental-health needs of refugee newcomers to Manitoba. During his directorship, the centre served 20,000 people, 7,000 of whom were refugees.

John oversaw Aurora's Dove of Peace Program, which provides a trauma-informed understanding of the settlement experiences of newcomers who have left behind mass violence. The federal government selected the program—the only one of its kind in Canada—to triage all newcomers to Winnipeg whose settlement pathway is affected by trauma.

He was the principal author and driving force in the creation of the Newcomer Collaborative Community Mental Health Service, which is a collaboration of community, community-based agencies, and the formal mental health system

designed to engage and provide service to newcomers with moderate to severe post-traumatic stress disorder.

John became the go-to expert on refugee trauma treatment in Canada by creating a space for and collaboration with people who have not been listened to in the past. He understands newcomers contribute valuable insight into the conditions for their own well-being. He believed community needs far exceeded any single agency or service and required collaboration to have a chance at success and make a difference in the life of so many people.

In 2016, he was one of four Canadians accepted into the acclaimed Certificate in Global Mental Health: Trauma and Recovery at Harvard.

Gentleness and humility continue to characterize John's personal style. Staff at Aurora have told him he has Ubuntu, an African philosophy of love and care in community, which loosely translates as, "I am because you are."

For developing groundbreaking mental-health programs and services for refugees and immigrants, and for his decades-long commitment to empowering marginalized and traumatized people, The University of Winnipeg is proud to bestow an Honorary Doctor of Laws on John Smyth.

## Honourees



### **Hon. Patricia Bovey**

LL.D, DCL, FRSA, FCMA, DFDS

#### **Honorary Doctor of Letters**

For over 50 years, Dr. Patricia Bovey has elevated and refined our understanding of Canadian art as a museologist, professor, art historian, gallery director, curator, mentor, and Senator.

Patricia's connection to the University began in the mid-1970s, when she was hired as its first art curator. She built an art collection that enhanced our campus, and taught some of the first art history courses here.

She later established the graduate program in Curatorial Practices—the first art-oriented Master of Arts program in Manitoba—and taught in it too, mentoring dozens of emerging curators who now lead cultural institutions across Canada.

She was Curator of the Winnipeg Art Gallery, and Director of both the Art Gallery of Greater Victoria and the Winnipeg Art Gallery. She also founded and directed the Buhler Gallery in St. Boniface Hospital, the first such gallery of its kind in Canada.

From 2016 to 2023, she served in the Senate of Canada, where she was instrumental in installing the first works of Black Canadian artists in the Red Chamber.

Patricia is also an esteemed author whose expertise is sought after from Scandinavia to Japan. In her public lectures and parliamentary addresses, she showed how art—especially art that presents difficult truths—is central to reconciliation.

A champion of diversity in the arts, Patricia has also consistently given voice to societal issues, from climate change to the legacy of residential schools, and has famously pointed out that if we want to comprehend our history, our present, and our future, we must look to the work of visual artists.

For establishing art history at UWinnipeg and for deep and abiding contributions to our appreciation of Canadian visual art, The University of Winnipeg is proud to bestow an Honorary Doctor of Letters on Patricia Bovey.

### **Dan Thomas**

Elder in Residence

#### **Honorary Doctor of Laws**

Dan Thomas is an esteemed Anishinaabe Elder, Spiritual Leader, Knowledge Carrier, and Traditional Teacher whose work in education has made a generational difference in Manitoba.

Dan grew up on Matheson Island, just north of Hecla, and currently lives near Gull Lake. He has been an educator his entire life, starting his career as a middle school and high school teacher.

Since the 1970s, he has educated the educators, leading workshops on cultural awareness and how to integrate Indigenous perspectives into the school curriculum.

For 17 years, he was a consultant for Manitoba Education, authoring education documents for the province and First Nations. He also developed Treaty education resources for the Treaty Relations Commission of Manitoba.

During his 14 years at the Manitoba First Nations Education Resource Centre, Dan developed many print and video resources about traditional teachings.

For the past 12 years, he has been an instructor in the University's Masters in Development Practice Program, where he teaches the course "Indigenous Thought and Worldviews," a perennial student favourite. He also offers students many experiential learning opportunities.

The breadth of his knowledge, together with his warmth, good humour and patience make him an inspiring educator.

Dan is also a University Elder-in-Residence, providing traditional teachings, guest lectures, counselling, and guidance.

Dan possesses a profound knowledge of Anishinaabe traditional teachings and history. He is a fifth-degree Midewiwin who is known for his humility, kindness, generosity, and compassion. He is loved and respected by students, faculty, and staff, and by Indigenous people across Turtle Island.

For making foundational contributions to curriculum development in Manitoba, and for furthering Indigenous education at all levels, The University of Winnipeg is proud to bestow an Honorary Doctor of Laws on Dan Thomas.

### **James Christie**

BA, MA, MDiv, DMin

#### **Professor Emeritus**

Dr. Reverend James Christie has been an outstanding educator, researcher and mentor, inspiring students and colleagues through his passion for academia in the field of theology for over 30 years.

His research in conflict and peace studies and his drive for innovative discourse to theology and scholarship is patent. Christie's scholarly advocacy as a charismatic communicator for interfaith dialogue brought intellectual gravitas to his role as teacher and member of the community.

His years of service as an educator has consistently demonstrated a passion for teaching, academic excellence, and a genuine concern for his students' success that has left an indelible impression on generations of students and colleagues.

His devotion to his work and impact as Dean and professor in the Faculty of Theology, Acting Dean of Global College, and co-founder of the Ridd Institute, Religion and Global Policy, has resonated beyond the university campus.

His groundbreaking research as an editor, contributor, and peer reviewer in several prestigious journals, solidifies his reputation as a leading expert in dialogue theology and world ecumenism.

Christie has been an impetus behind major initiatives internationally, having served on faculties and boards on some of the most prestigious institutions engaging in peacebuilding activities globally.

Beyond his academic achievements, Christie has been an invaluable ambassador for UWinnipeg. His membership and service on various boards and committees earned him UWinnipeg's Clarence Atchison Award for Community Service in 2008. This includes serving the G8 Religious Leaders Summit, G20 Interfaith Forum Advisory Board, United Church of Canada, and Umunna Igbo Association of Manitoba.

UWinnipeg bestows upon Reverend James Christie the title of Professor Emeritus for his dedication, and contributions to teaching, research and scholarship, and community.

## Honourees



### **Peggy L. Day**

BA, MA, MTS, PhD

#### **Professor Emerita**

Dr. Peggy L. Day has diligently served The University of Winnipeg for over three decades, as a scholar, teacher, and administrator. She is renowned for her brilliance and thoughtful engagements in her field of study and for her administrative acumen.

She completed her PhD in Ancient Near Eastern Languages and Civilization at Harvard University in 1986, and was one of the first scholars to engage in feminist historical study of the Hebrew Bible/Old Testament, in what remains a heavily male-dominated field.

She went on to make an impressive contribution with her academic productivity and numerous publications, while teaching in her primary field of expertise, the Hebrew Bible.

Her most recent research examines primary and secondary material on the internees of the World War II Japanese POW and internment camp at Batu Lintang, in present-day Malaysian Borneo.

As a teacher, Dr. Day has made an ineradicable impression upon generations of students, including several who went on to do graduate work as a result of her mentoring. Dr. Day was also equally dedicated to mentoring and supporting junior academics in the department.

As Chair of the Department of Religion and Culture for over 15 years, she was an ardent champion for the department who led changing the shape of the curriculum, and made significant contributions to university governance.

The University of Winnipeg honours Dr. Peggy L. Day with the title of Professor Emerita for her continued intellectual and scholarly engagement, which has earned admiration and collegial respect.

### Stephanie Rozzi

Diploma in Human Resources  
and Management PACE, BA (Geography)

#### Stars of Spence Street Prize

Stephanie Rozzi has worked with thousands of students at The University of Winnipeg, and has offered her time, care, and creativity with each one.

Her career has included contributions in several areas of Student Services, but her main focus has been academic advising and recognition of prior learning for adult learners. Stephanie has served this important group of students with diligence and dedication for twenty years.

## Honourees



### **Xiao-Yuan Dong**

BA, MA, PhD

#### **Professor Emerita**

Since arriving at UWinnipeg in 1993, Xiao-Yuan Dong established herself as a leading internationally reputed expert on China's economic transformation and its gender implications. Dong, by example, has furthered the status of women in the field of economics while mentoring others.

Her work lays down important empirical foundations for understanding how China's economy developed since the mid-twentieth century, affecting men and women differently. Her work has helped promote gender responsive policy-making in China.

Over the last two decades, she has made it her mission to mentor young Chinese female economists through the Chinese Women Economists Research Training Program at the China Centre for Economic Research, a program she co-founded with her colleague Zhao Yaohui of Peking University.

Their program has contributed to improving research capacity for Chinese female economists, raising their visibility, and has created new generations of female economists in China.

Her commitment to gender equality includes an undergraduate course she created on gender and the economy and a chapter on gender issues for a graduate-level course at UWinnipeg, all while she actively participated in its governance.

Her equity work was recognized by the Canadian Women Economics Committee which honored Dong with the Sylvia Ostry Award for furthering the status of women in economics through achievement and mentorship.

Dong is a widely cited, highly accomplished researcher.

She has published 93 journal articles, book chapters, and policy reports. Her research had been funded by The Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada, International Development Research Centre, and the Ford Foundation, to list a few. Her research has earned her UWinnipeg's Erica and Arnold Rogers Award for Excellence in Research and Scholarship in 2006.

For Dong's excellence in research, teaching, and service over her distinguished career, and for advancing economics for women across continents, UWinnipeg bestows upon her the title of Professor Emerita.

### **Ava Stokke**

Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics and English

#### **Valedictorian**

Ava chose to study at The University of Winnipeg because of its small class sizes, but also because of its reputation as an excellent liberal arts university. Since she was uncertain about what degree she wanted to pursue, it was important the university had the flexibility of choosing an arts or science degree.

#### Valedictorian
