This year's honouree and keynote speaker is Ms. Jay Grewal, President and CEO of Manitoba Hydro. Appointed in February 2019, Jay is the first woman to hold this position in the utility's 58-year history. She has held a series of executive roles in British Columbia and the Northwest Territories in the utility, resource and consulting sectors, including that of Chief Financial Officer of BC Hydro. Ms. Grewal has also been an active member of various non-profit boards, including the BC United Way Campaign Cabinet, the BC Children's Hospital Miracle Network, and the UBC Board of Governors.

The India Centre is a partnership between The India Association of Manitoba and The University of Winnipeg. Since our inception in 2013, we have raised over \$100,000 through our Annual Awards Dinners and other events. These funds support various initiatives including:

- › The creation of an endowment fund at the University of Winnipeg, allowing us to give back to the community now while also leaving a legacy for the future. Proceeds from the fund are earmarked to support students in initiatives that embody the aims of The Centre
- › The India Centre Bursaries which provide funding support to students with financial need from Manitoba's Indo-Canadian community who wish to study at The University of Winnipeg
- › Hosting delegates from India for business-to-business workshops
- › A series of public forum and concert events which further our aim to build cross-cultural bridges
- › The facilitation of new partnerships with Indian universities toward the exchange of faculty and students, promotion of dual degrees, and the establishment and promotion of research networks
