### **Research Strengths**

York's philosophy department is the highest ranked in Canada for Philosophy of Cognitive Science, and second in Canada for Philosophy of Law and American Pragmatism.

## Funding

**Philosophy Speaker Series:** regular talks each term by visiting philosophers

Metaethics reading group: biweekly meetings

Annual York University Seminar in Early Modern Philosophy, organized by Matthew. Leisinger, Johnathan Cottrell & Zeyad el Nabolsy

**Cognitive Science Workshop:** biweekly meeting where faculty and graduate students share works in progress, test ideas, practice talks, etc.

**Ontario Mind Group (OMG):** monthly meetings with the philosophy of mind community in Toronto, includes dinner and two talks

**GTA Animal Cognition Discussion Group:** monthly meeting of philosophers and scientists from the Greater Toronto Area to discuss the latest work on animal cognition

The **Centre for Vision Research** hosts a weekly Seminar Series, biennial workshop & other events.

The Philosophy of Perception Reading Group: attended regularly by philosophers and perception scientists

**Annual graduate student conference.** Last year's topic: The Philosophy of Animal Minds

**Monthly graduate student colloquium**, where 3-4 graduate students present for about 20-30 minutes and then take a Q&A on their work

PhD students receive guaranteed funding for 5 years.

Connected Minds PhD Scholarships are available (\$10k/year for up to 4 years).

LA&PS dissertation fieldwork fellowships: students who have defended their dissertation proposal by the end of their 3rd year can get a year of dissertation fellowship (full funding, no teaching) for their 4th year.

Graduate Fellowship of Distinction in Philosophy: students in 4th or 5th year can apply for up to 3 terms of teaching relief to finish dissertation (\$8000/term).

**Travel funding:** \$1500/year in travel funding for PhD students, \$750/year for MA students, FGS's Academic Excellence Fund gives \$1500/year

Barrantes Prize: annual essay prize in philosophy, open to all graduate students, \$5000 for 1st place, \$3000 for 2nd place, \$2000 for 3rd place

Graduate students are encouraged to apply for, and are offered strong support by the department in applying for, SSHRC Doctoral Fellowships (\$40k/yr for up to 3 years), Canada Graduate Scholarship (\$27,000 for one year), Ontario Graduate Scholarships (\$5000/term).
