From May 2023 to April 2024, the SCC approved the following:

- Experimental Courses – 21 credit hours
- Inactive Courses – 3 credit hours

The committee recommended the following courses be approved by Senate.

- New Courses – 111/123 credit hours
- Course Revisions – 242/245 credit hours
- Course Deletions – 132 credit hours

- HIST-3625 (3) History of the Métis
- UIC-3010 (3)/IS-3011 (3) Two-Spirit, Indigiqueer, & Indigenous LGBTQ Realities

The SCC received the following submissions by the 2024 curriculum deadline (extended to April 8):

- New courses – 213/222 credit hours
- Course Revisions – 270 credit hours
- Course Deletions – 51 credit hours

The SCC thanks the DCCs, DCC chairs, and department assistants for the careful attention given to their submissions, and for working collaboratively with other departments and programs on curriculum matters. We also thank the subject Librarians for their work on the library consults that accompany new course proposals.
